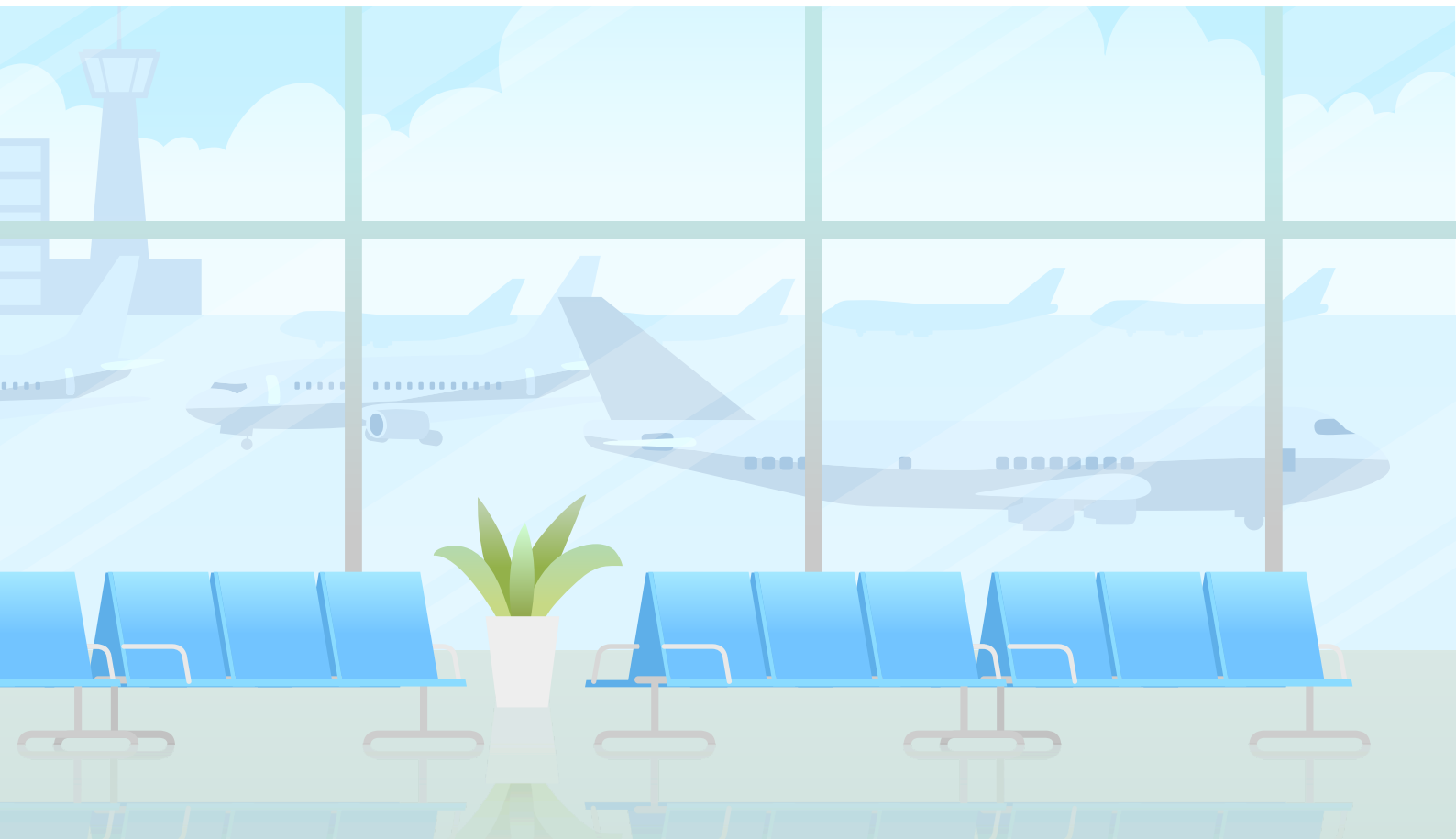

- 1** Check-in and check your **baggage**: The first thing to do when you get into the airport is find the check-in and baggage counter. Make sure you check the allowed weight before you get to the airport!
- 2** Pass through **Security**: After you check your **baggage** and check-in, it's time to pass through security. I was pretty nervous for this part, but the security workers are only looking to make sure nothing dangerous gets on the plane.
- 3** Find the **Gate**: Now that you've put your shoes and your belt back on, it's time to find the gate. This is where you will finally board the plane. Almost there!
- 4** **Board** the Plane: I hope you're ready. It's time to go! To board the plane, wait until your section of the plane is called. Are you sitting on by the window, aisle, or middle seat? Helen likes the aisle so she can get up more often, while Zach prefers the window in order to see the sky above and lands below.
- 5** Enjoy the **flight**: Now that you're on the plane, you're a passenger. Passengers are people who are riding planes, trains, or buses. The seat space may be uncomfortable, but there are still movies and snacks!
